Welcome strangers.

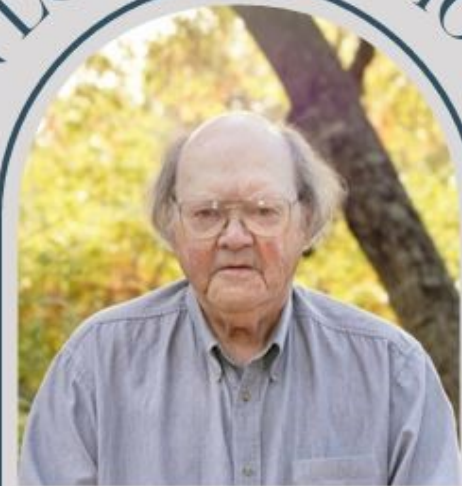
