but room to grow.

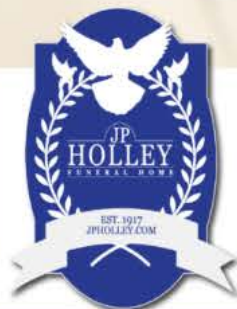
And when we learn its language,
