Don't cry for me, For I have no fear.

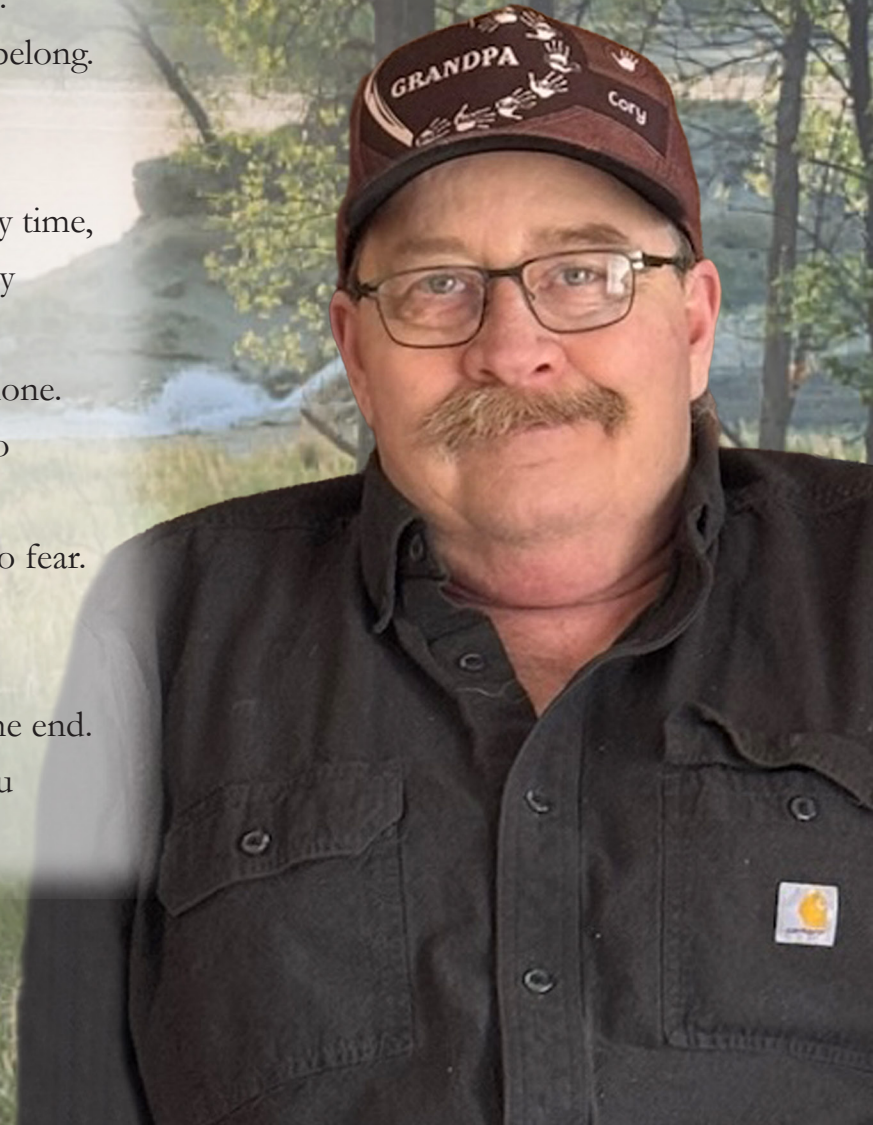
All my pain is gone,
