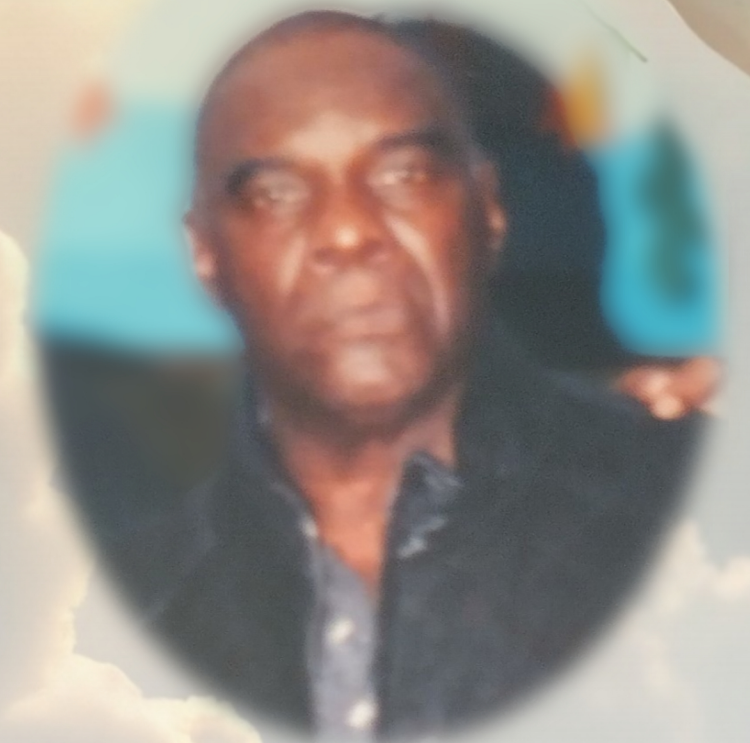

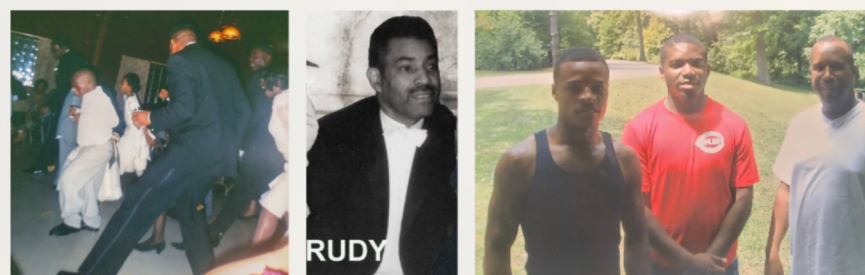
Preceded in death Sons Cassanova (Gabby) White Jr, Antonio (Tony) Garnett, Brothers Samuel, Arnold and Roger White.
