my hand. I'll take you from your pain, your strife,

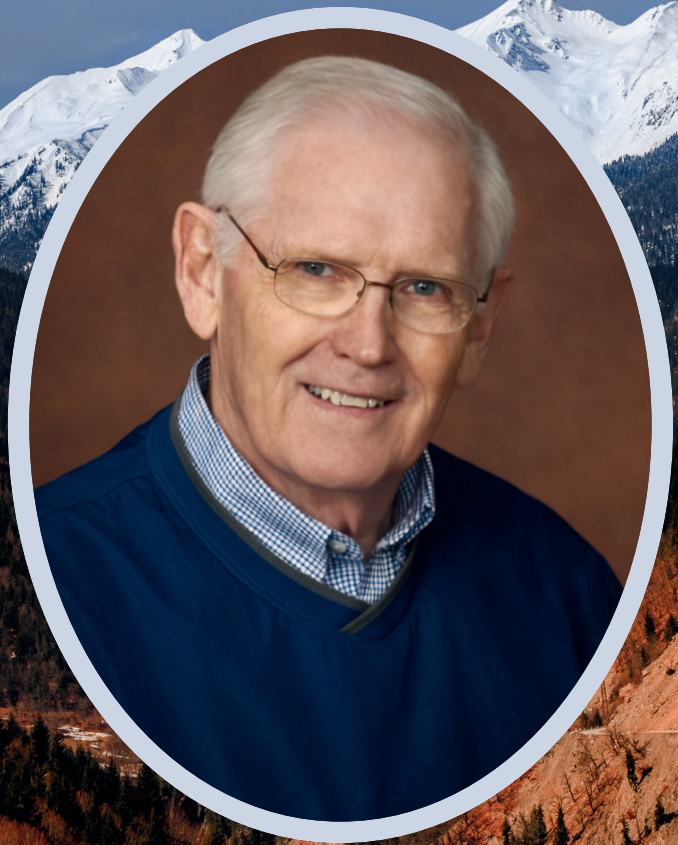
Today you graduate from mortal life.
