

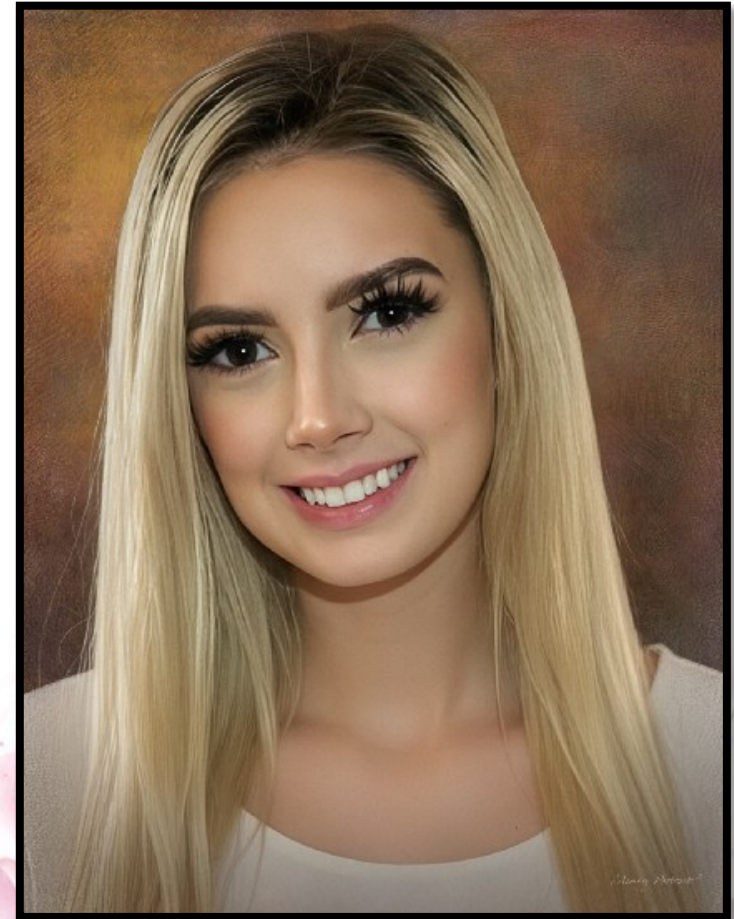
*In Loving Memory of*
