He'll prepare for us a place.

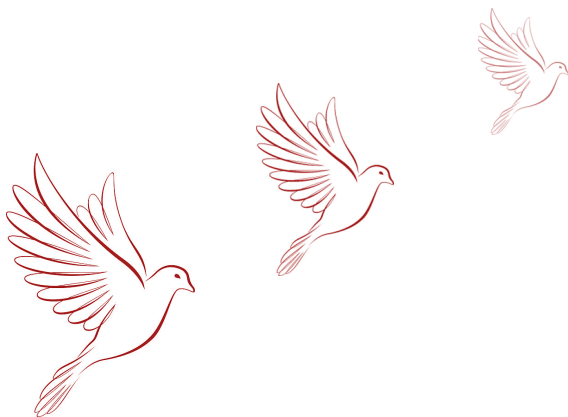
Refrain:
