He communicated more through his expressions and the happiness he found in simple things than through words. Those who loved him learned to celebrate the little moments - a smile, a laugh, and the delight of a favorite toy. His life reminded us that love doesn't depend on words.

Although he faced significant challenges throughout his life due to disabilities, he brought joy to those who knew him in his own unique way. He enjoyed going to church, loved riding in the car and listening and moving to music, (his favorite was the closing credits music from "The Chosen") - but most of all he loved his ratty balls and his "hand balloons" (latex gloves). His smile and quiet presence touched the hearts of his family.
