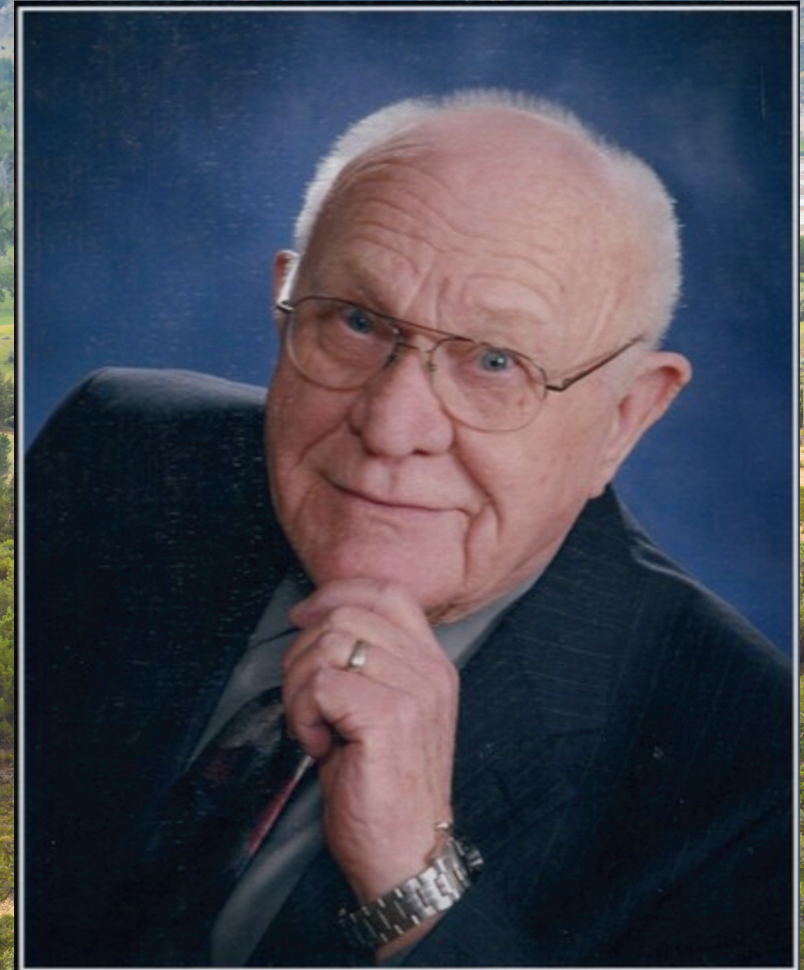
Doris passed away in 2003.
