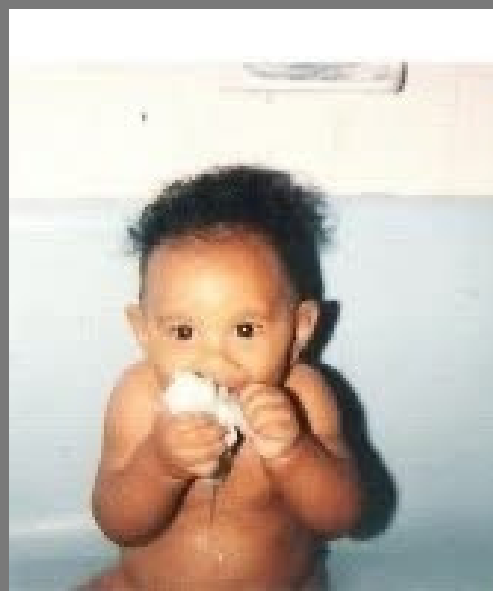

Obituary



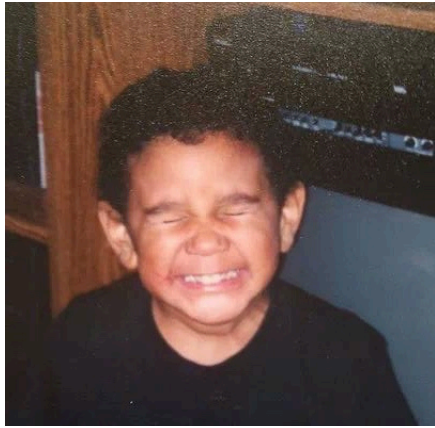

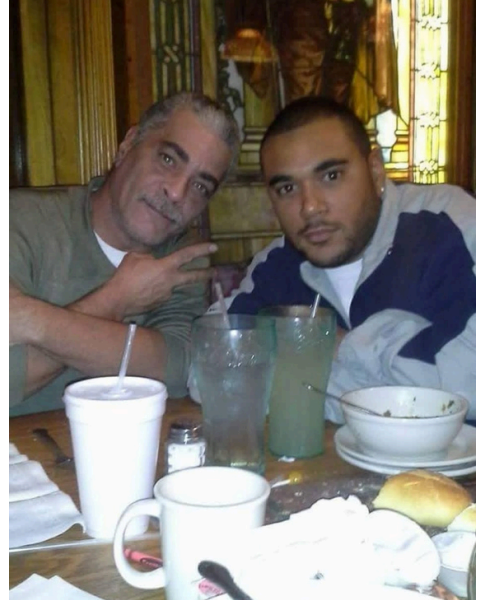

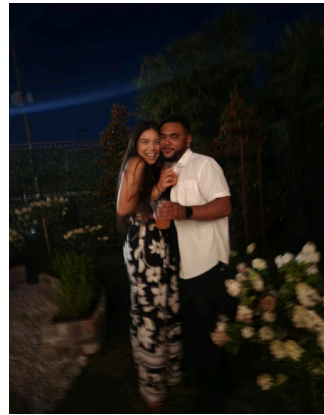
