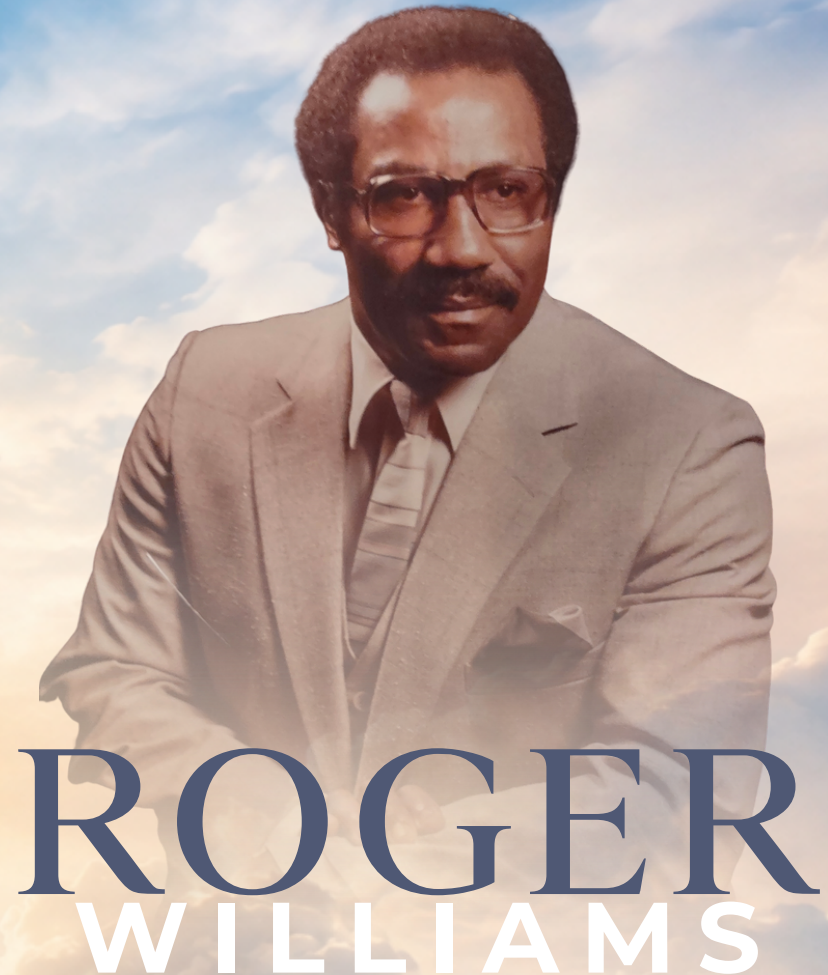

REFLECTIONS OF HIS LIFE

Roger Williams was born on January 30, 1937 in Sandy Run, in Calhoun County, South Carolina, to the late Daniel Williams, Jr. and Maggie Rumph Favor. Roger's paternal grandparents were the late Mr. and Mrs. Daniel Williams, Sr., of Sandy Run, Calhoun County, South Carolina. Roger's maternal grandmother was the late Isabelle Favor. He departed this life on August 3, 2026.

Mr. Williams was educated in the public schools of Richland County, Columbia, South Carolina. Roger commenced his high school education at Booker T. Washington High School (Tornadoes) in Richland County, Columbia, South Carolina.

Roger took a sabbatical from high school to enlist in the United States Arms Forces. Roger was part of the elite Screaming Eagles Airborne Division of the United States Army and was based out of Tacoma, Washington.

Education was very important to Roger. After a tour of duty in Germany, Roger returned to Columbia, South Carolina, to complete his high school education, graduating in 1959 from Booker T. Washington High School.

Roger demonstrated that he was a gifted athletic while a student at Booker T. Washington High School (Tornadoes). Roger was a member of the Booker T. Washington High School Football team.

It was during the latter part of his high school years at Booker T. Washington High School where Roger met the love of his life, Mary Alice Davis. They were married on December 9, 1958.

Roger had a life-long career as a medical assistant at the Veterans Administration Hospital. Roger retired after thirty years from the Veterans Administration Hospital in Columbia, South Carolina.

He was a life member of the Knights of Columbus, and one of the founding members of the Towns Men's Club in Columbia, South Carolina.

Roger was a devoted member of the Catholic faith, and attended Saint Martin De Porres Catholic Church in Columbia, South Carolina.

Roger was preceded in death by his two brothers Allen Favor, SFC Thomas Lee Favor, two sisters, Mattie Mae Favor, and Sadie Favor.
