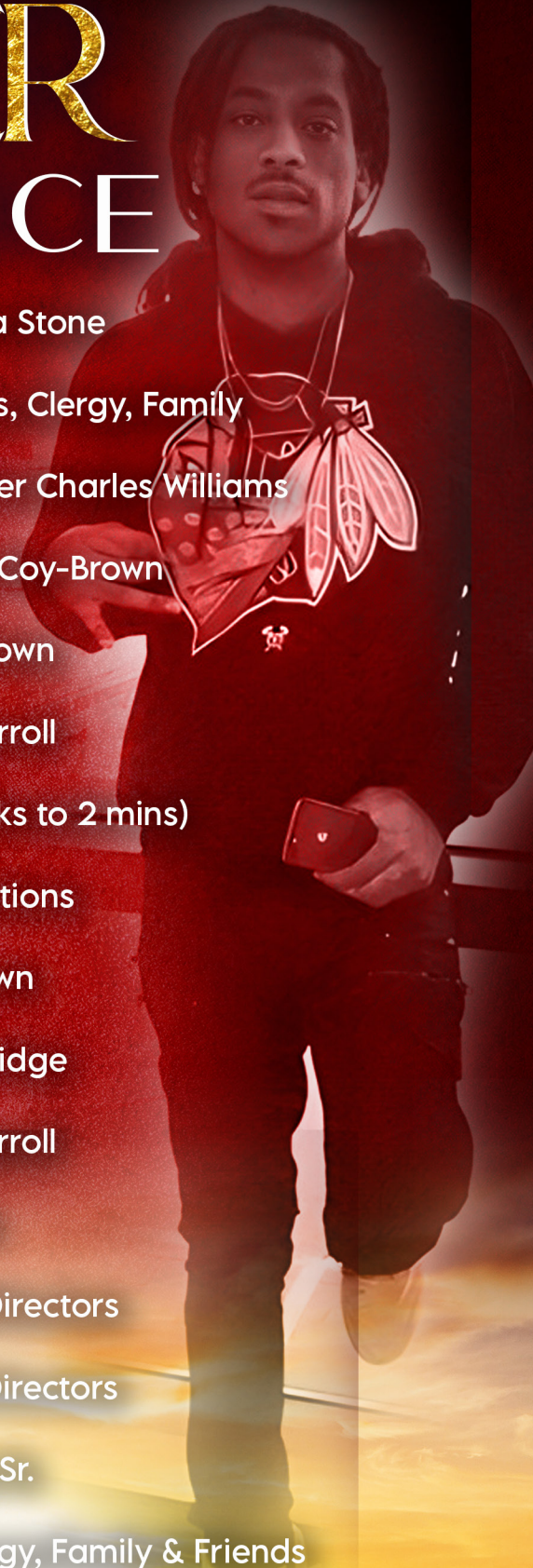

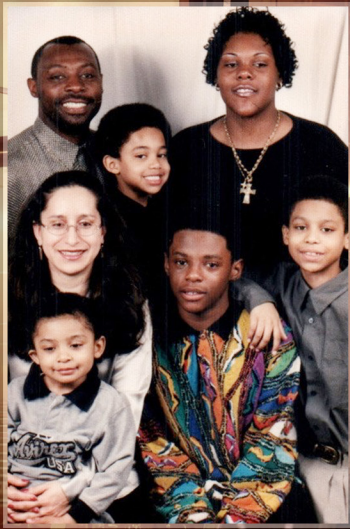
I NEVER LEFT YOU
