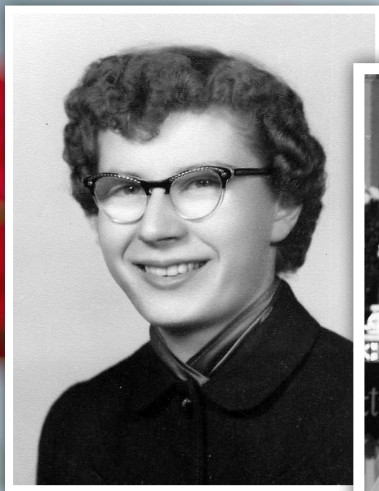




Celebrating the Life of

Teresa M. Preuschl, 88, of Garner passed away on Friday, June 26, 2026, at her home.
