Rollin Cecil Smith was born October 24, 1932 to Cecil and Alta (Foster) Smith in Syracuse, NY. He graduated from Baldwinsville Academy and Central High School in Baldwinsville, NY in 1950. After high school he worked for two years then attended Syracuse College for a year before beginning his employment with Goodyear Tire Company in 1954. After 37 years with Goodyear, Rollin retired. Rollin showed palominos and quarter horses in the Eastern States until 1965. He owned two bucking bulls: Banny Rooster and Harry. He loved to travel.
