**Her Education:** In Gary, Indiana, Wendy attended Ivanhoe Elementary, Edison Middle School, and she was a 1984 graduate of West Side High School. Later, Wendy attended Vincennes University in Vincennes, Indiana, with studies in Marketing and Interior Designs. She obtained a certificate from Career Blazers Learning Center in Atlanta, Georgia as a PC Specialist.

**Her Profession:** Wendy enriched the lives of many children as a Teacher at Harvest Rain Early Learning Academy and was a talented Seamstress at AI Alterations in Buckhead, Georgia. For the last 13 years, she has been a Customer Service Representative at DHL Express.


