Celebrating the Life of Mrs. Lucile Harris Wright

Lucile Harris Wright was born on August 14, 1919, in Metter, GA. She was the tenth out of twelve siblings born to sharecroppers Steve and Francis Harris. Since 2008 Lucile was the last survivor out of all her 11 siblings. Now, they have all been reunited.

Lucile was educated in Metter and later moved to Savannah where she soon met and married the love of her life, Clarence Wright. Shortly afterwards, they moved to New York City.

Lucile worked for many years as a Nurses' Aid at Bellevue Hospital and Clarence was a taxi driver and musician. Many years later, they retired and moved back to Savannah to live out the remainder of their lives together. She became a long-time member of Speedwell United Methodist Church where she served as a Communion Stewardess and a member of the Super Seniors Club. She also served in other capacities in her church and the Sandfly community.






