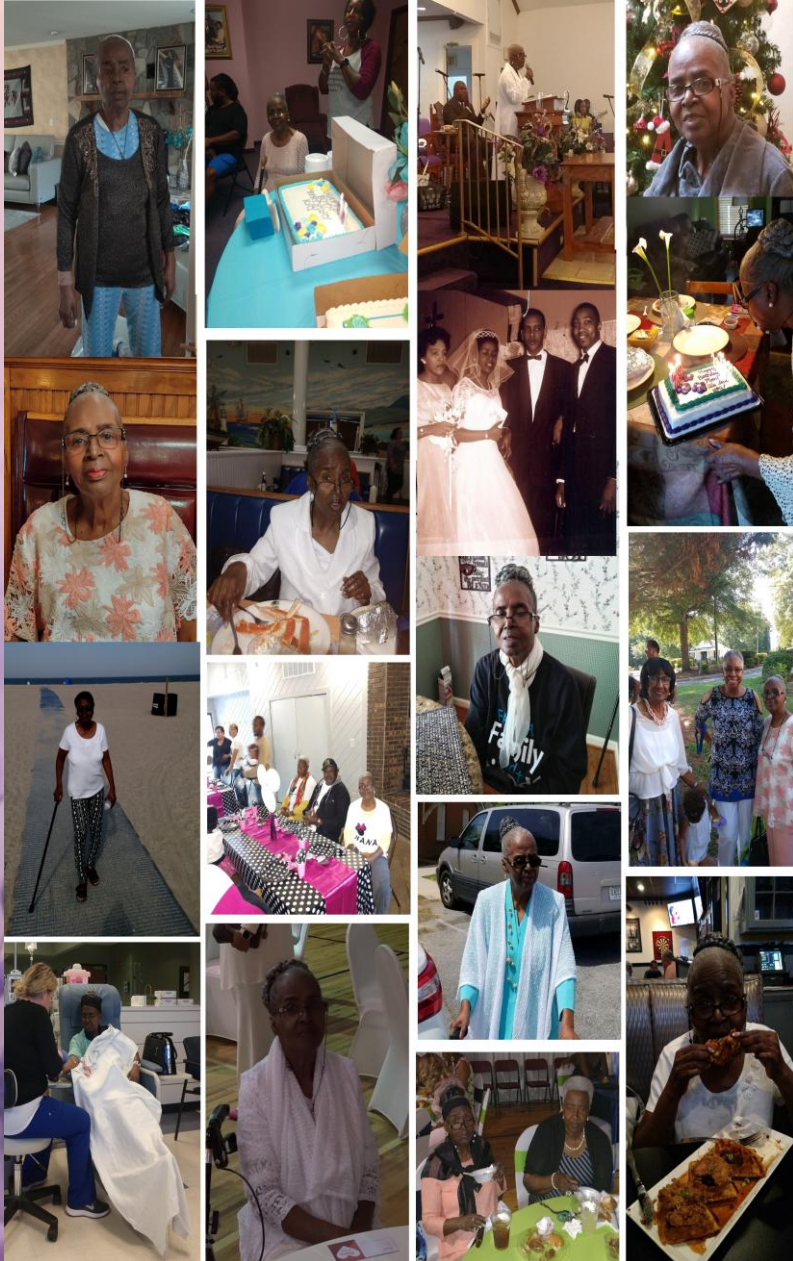

Our friend and pastor is home at last.*



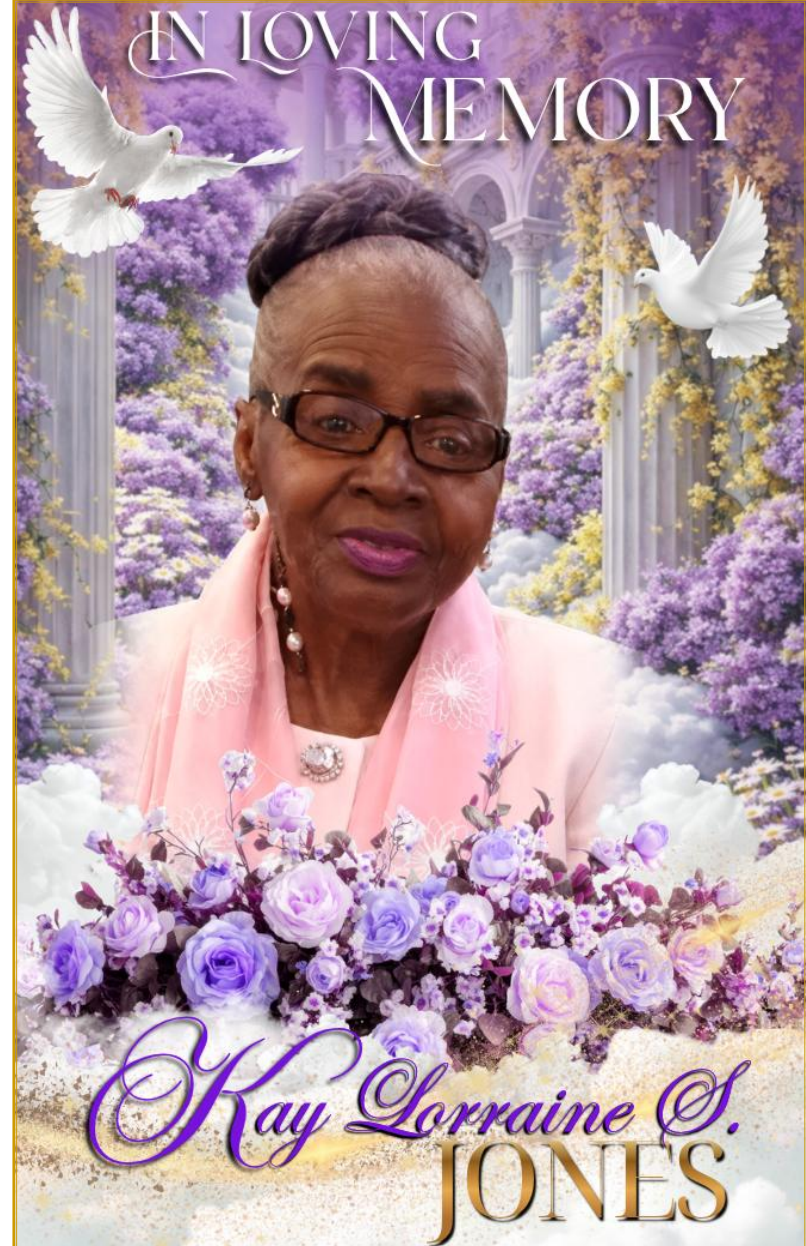

Reverend Kay Lorraine Jones was born on September 23, 1938, in Edenton, North Carolina, to Percy Spruill and Annie Fayton.

She was educated in the public schools of Norfolk, Virginia where she was a graduate of the Crestwood High School Class of 1956. She furthered her education at Virgia State University.

Kay was employed with MSI Electronics from the early 1970's until her retirement. There, she made specialized gold diodes which were used in various electronic application including NASA's space shuttle program.

Kay was a member of Bethesda Missionary Baptist Church where she sang on the choir. She also attended Greater Saint Stevens Baptist Church where she served as the Minister of Music and Holy Unity Baptist Church.

She served as the Worthy Matron of Rosebud Chapter 561, OES. She was the associate conductress of the Metro State Grand Chapter, she organized the Court of Isis, and was the Daughter of the Dessert.
