**Barbara Ann Possail** was born on December 14, 1940 to Everett and Marjorie (Rokeh) Giles on a farm near Hendricks, Minnesota. She attended a country school in Brookings County through the 8<sup>th</sup> grade. She was confirmed in the faith in 1952 at the Methodist church in Hendricks. She began 9<sup>th</sup> grade in Hendricks for a few weeks until her mom and siblings moved to Marshall, Minnesota. In the summer of 1956 their father, Everett passed away, which is what prompted the family's move to Marshall. During her high school years, she worked at Reines Café in Marshall. After graduation she met Jerald Possail and the two were united in marriage on November 27, 1961, at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Tyler, Minnesota. The couple purchased the farm in Marshfield Township, Lincoln County, Minnesota where they farmed their entire married life. They raised pigs, sheep, and horses for many years.
