the valley of the shadow of death,*

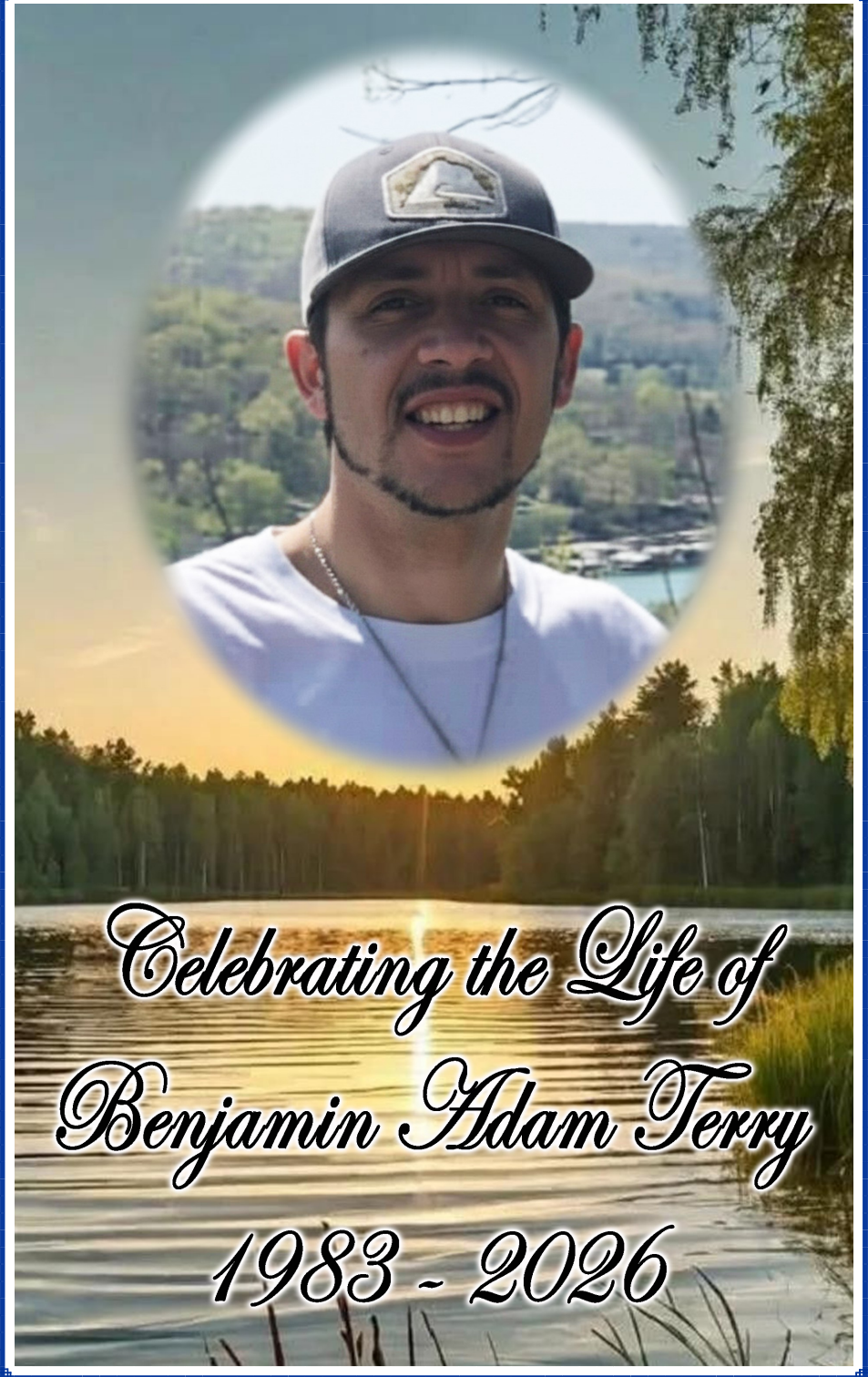
*I will fear no evil, for you are with me;
