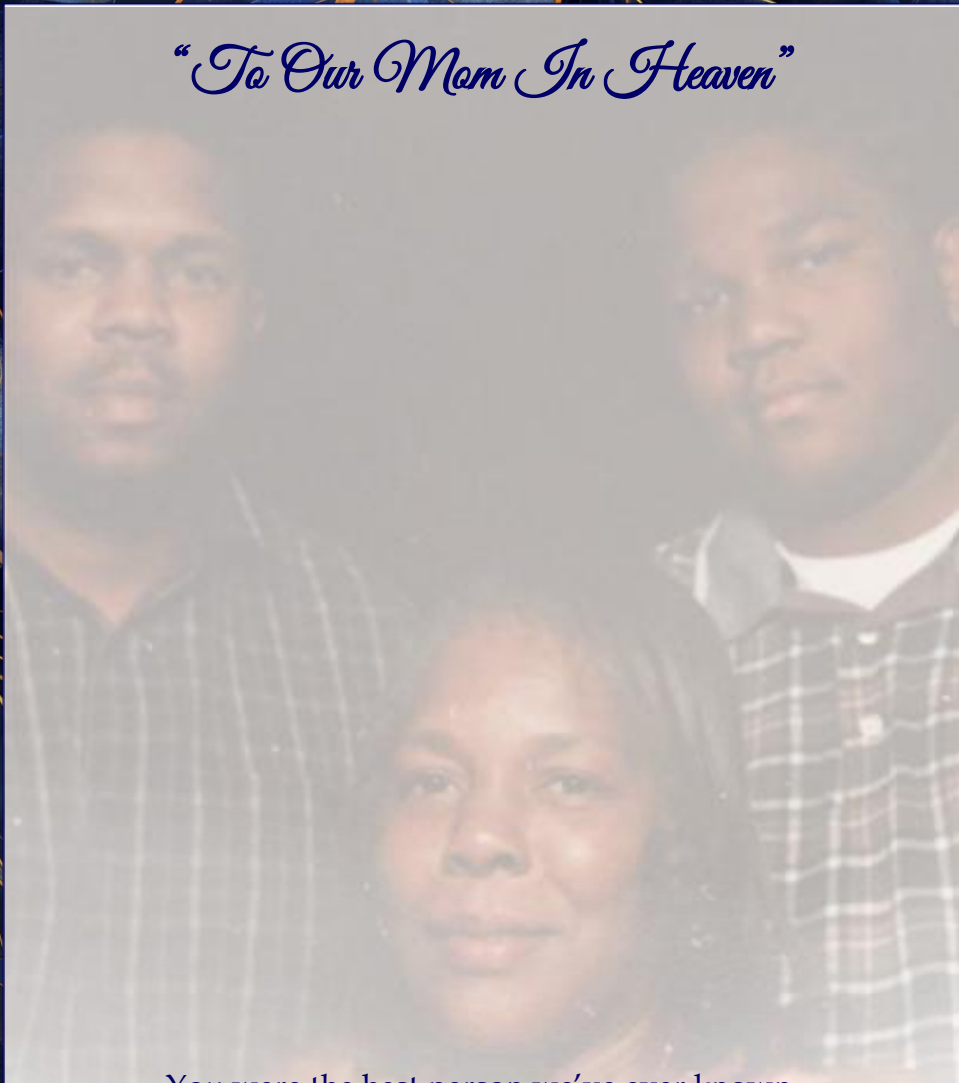
*As I look back over time I find myself wondering...
