She is preceded in death by her mother and father.

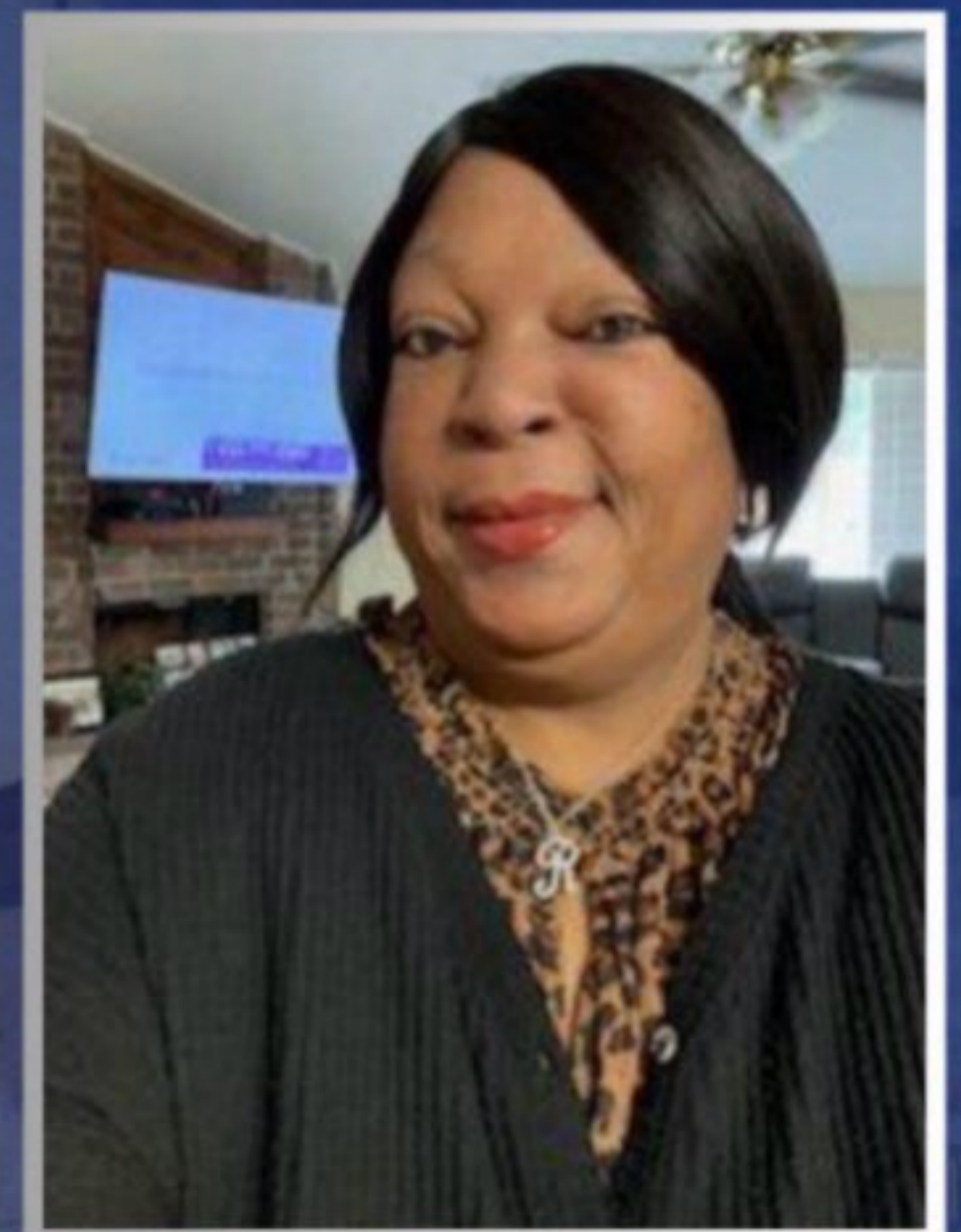

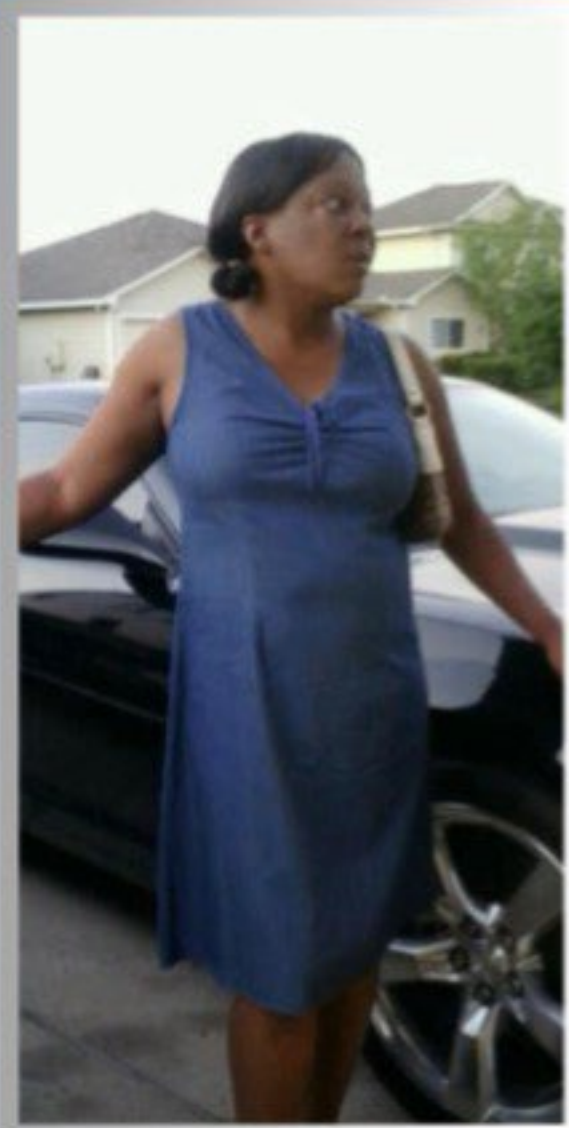

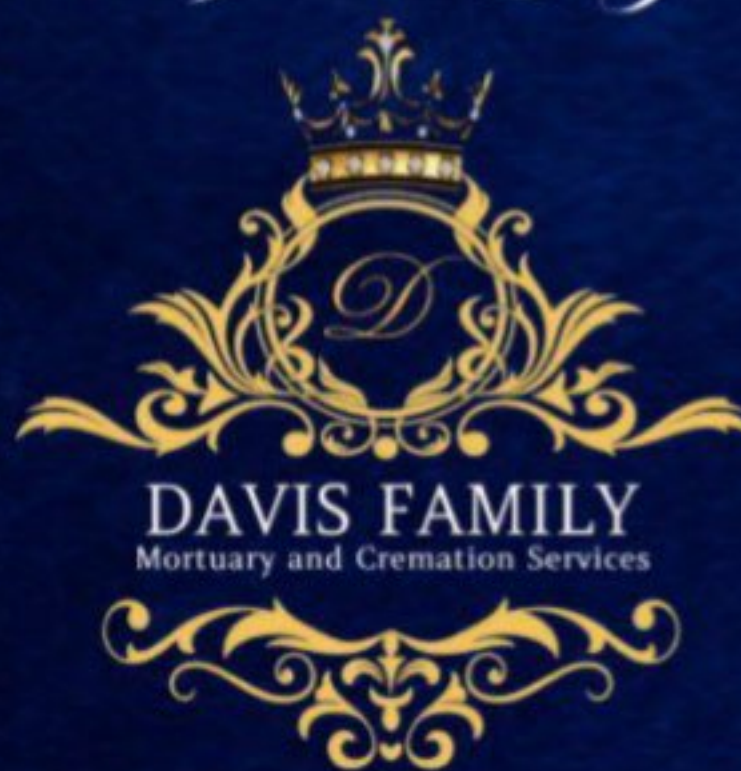
