Gloria Jean King-Price, was born on June 23, 1952 in Dillon, SC to Bessie Lee & King David (both were preceded in death). In 1958, she moved to Philadelphia along with her mother and two brothers, David and James whom she loved dearly and shared a special bond. She was raised in Philadelphia by her mother Bessie and Richard King (both preceded in death), and continued to live in Philadelphia until the timing of her departure on May 24, 2025. Gloria was educated in the Philadelphia School System, where she graduated with her high school diploma from Kensington High School.

Gloria received a certificate of completion from Watterson Business School for nursing assistant. Gloria loved children. She worked in daycares and schools, retiring from the School District of Philadelphia after 27 years of service.

Gloria met her friend and love of her life, Roosevelt Price in 1990. They remained connected throughout the years, marrying in June 2009 surrounded by family and friends. They could be seen together on any given day with their well-coordinated matching outfits shopping, travelling, going on cruises, enjoying concerts in Penns Landing, taking bus trips to the casino, dinner with family and friends or just enjoying a nice day sitting on the front porch, all of which were some of Gloria's favorite things to do.

Gloria joined New Psalmist Baptist church where she served 20+ years in different ministry capacities including choir member, Pastor's Aide, usher board and the praise dance team. She even led a few neighbors and family to join the church. She loved the Lord and lived a life of prayer & worship. She would burst out into tears and praise at any given moment, always thanking God for even the simple things. Gloria had a heart for serving and supporting others. She supported other ministries throughout the years at annual services, trips, bible study, prayer, fundraisers, community days, clothing drives and concerts. Over the past 5 years, she supported ministries through online service gatherings.

Gloria loved going to Wildwood, Atlantic City and Disney with her family. She loved taking quick "girls trips" to New York or Baltimore Harbor with her nieces whom she treated as daughters. In the neighborhood, she served as block captain (loved a good block party & line-dancing), sold water ice and looked after the neighborhood kids while sitting on her porch. Gloria loved cooking and a good sweet treat, especially sweet potato pie. She also loved to shop and strategically bought gifts throughout the year to put up for birthdays and Christmas' presents for her loved ones.

Gloria had one son affectionately known as "Joe-Joe" (was preceded in death) and nephew (son) Tyreek whom she loved dearly; however, she was like a 2nd mother to generations of her nieces and nephews (many of which she would babysit or lend a helping hand in raising).
