## Obituary

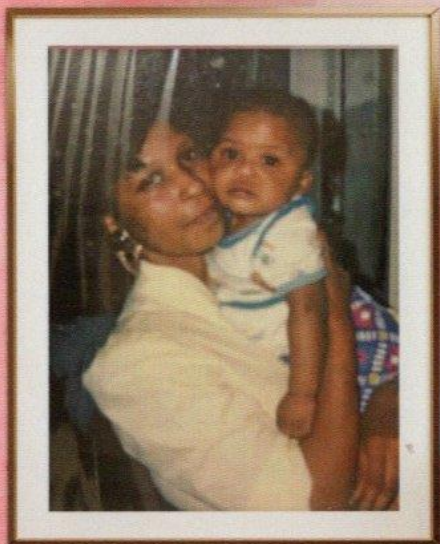

Rest in Peace, Blanch Elaine Gardner.

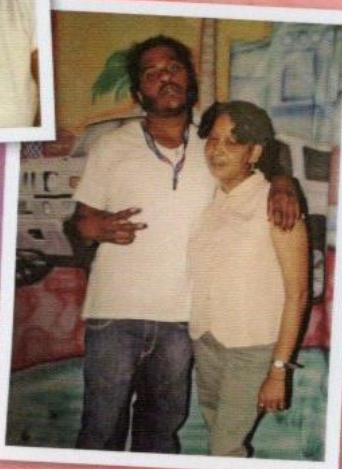
### **Our Beautiful Butterfly!**
