Marcus Allen Kindsfater was born July 20, 1991, at Belle Fourche, SD, to Steve and Lori (Dunbar) Kindsfater. He grew up in Sturgis where he attended Sturgis Public Schools. He participated in football and track. His favorite subjects included science, agriculture, and socializing with his wide circle of friends. After completing his education, he

was employed as a beekeeper near Belfield, ND. He worked in the oil patch for a year before moving back to Sturgis. At the time of his death he was a heavy equipment operator in construction.

Marcus enjoyed listening to music, hunting, fishing, camping, cooking, the outdoors, and his great friends.

Marcus, 21, Sturgis, died Sunday, September 23, 2012, as the result of an automobile accident.
