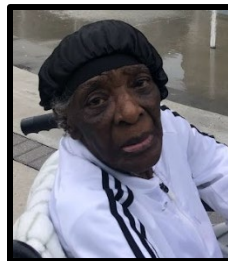
*Pearlie attended Yazoo County Schools until she left for agricultural work. She worked until her health failed.*
