


23rd Psalm



Obituary

Roy Whiting was born on September 26, 1942, in Hayneville, Alabama. He is one of nine children born to Charlie (Jr.) and Elizabeth Whiting. Roy attended Calhoun High School and after graduation, he served four years in the United States Marine Corps, two of which were spent in Vietnam.

Roy was dedicated to serving his country by receiving training in Leadership, and completing the Survival, Evasion, Resistance to Interrogation, and Escape Courses. He was Honorably discharged in September 1967 and during his military service was honored with the Vietnamese Service Medal, Vietnamese Campaign Medal, National Defense Service Medal, Good Conduct Medal, and the Pistol Sharpshooter and Rifle Expert Badges.

After leaving the Marines, Roy worked at the Lukenheimer Company in Cincinnati, and for twenty-two years worked at Procter & Gamble in Cincinnati as a Research Associate, retiring in 2015.

On November 21, 1970, Roy married Alberta Arrington and to this union were born two children. He leaves to cherish his loving wife of 52 years Alberta, son Micheal Whiting (Tiffany Abbott) of Cincinnati, daughter Angela Whiting (Travis Chambers) of Nashville, Tennessee, and grandchildren: Morgan and Reagan Whiting. He also leaves to cherish three brothers: Carl Whiting of Cincinnati, Charlie (Loretta) Whiting III of Monroeville, AL, Thomas (Betty) Whiting of Hayneville, AL; five sisters: Ethel Hawkins of Haure De Grace, Maryland, Magnolia Whiting and Mary Whiting of Boston, MA, Mahalia (Rodney) Johnson of Montgomery, AL, and Rosie Whiting of Hayneville, AL; a host of other family and friends.
