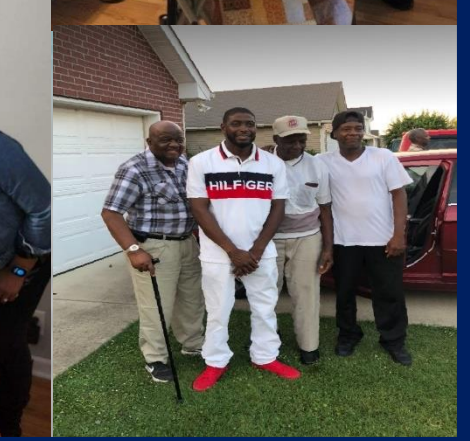
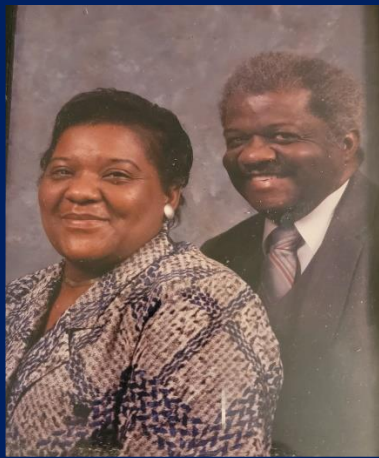

Mr. Robert Lewis Pearson was born on March 3rd, 1933 to the union of the late Jessie L. Pearson and Lillie Mae Pearson of Wildersville, TN in Henderson County.

In 1951 Robert, better known locally as Jabbo, graduated from Montgomery High School and soon enlisted into the United States Airforce, where he served during the Korean War. After his time in the military was over, Mr. Pearson began his working career at the Milan Army Ammunition Plant in Milan, TN where he worked for a number of years, even working elsewhere and returning to Milan where he retired in 1995. One of the things that Jabbo loved to do was work on cars and fix things himself, he was very good with his hands and a self-proclaimed “household engineer” as he would sometimes tell members of the family.

Robert was a dedicated member of Pilgrim Rest Missionary Baptist Church and even served as a deacon for many years, also a dedicated trustee and even singing in the male chorus as well. He served faithfully until he was no longer able to live by himself at his home and eventually had to move to Murfreesboro TN to live with family.

On Wednesday, December 18th, our loving father departed from this earthly home. For we know that if our earthly house of this tabernacle were dissolved, we have a building of GOD not made by our hands, eternal in the heavens. He is preceded in death by his loving wife June Marie Steele-Pearson, his parents, seven brothers, three sisters and one daughter Anita G. Nana.
