Lisa enjoyed gardening, music and random "spur-of-the-moment" dance parties (especially with her grandkids). She also loved anything involving arts & crafts, making delicious home-cooked meals, & attending all of her kids & grandkids events. You knew when Lisa attended as she always cheered the loudest.


