I'm walking in your footsteps

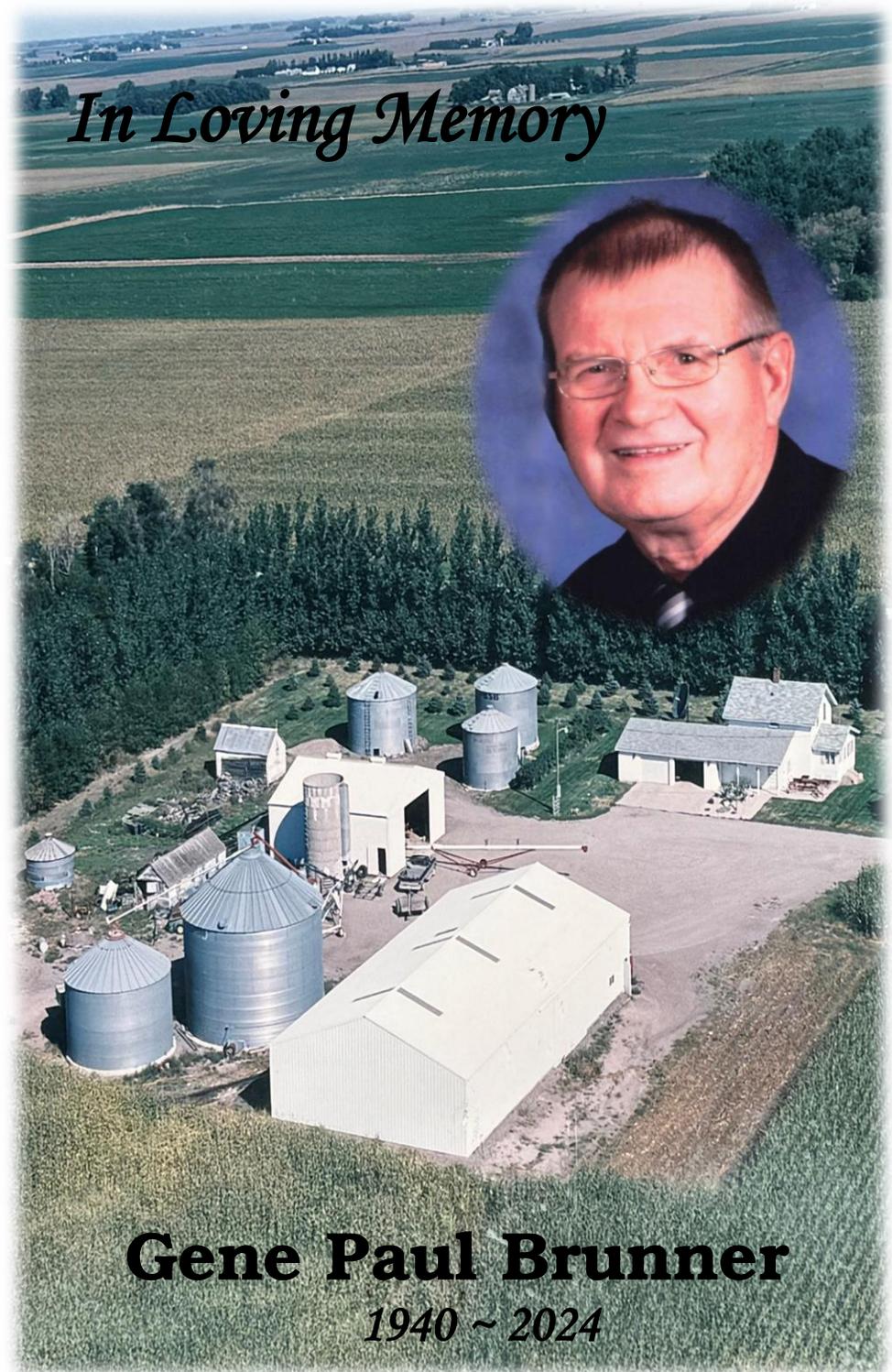
Only half a step behind.
