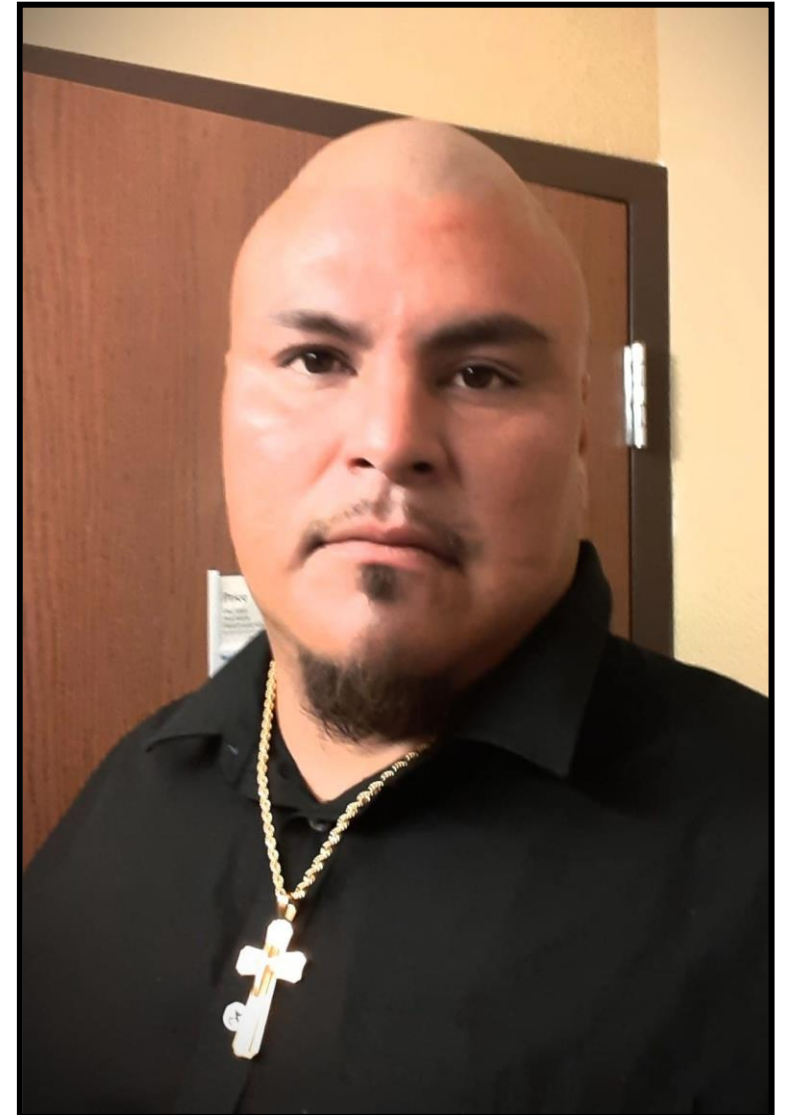
many aunts, uncles, cousins, nieces & nephews too many to mention
