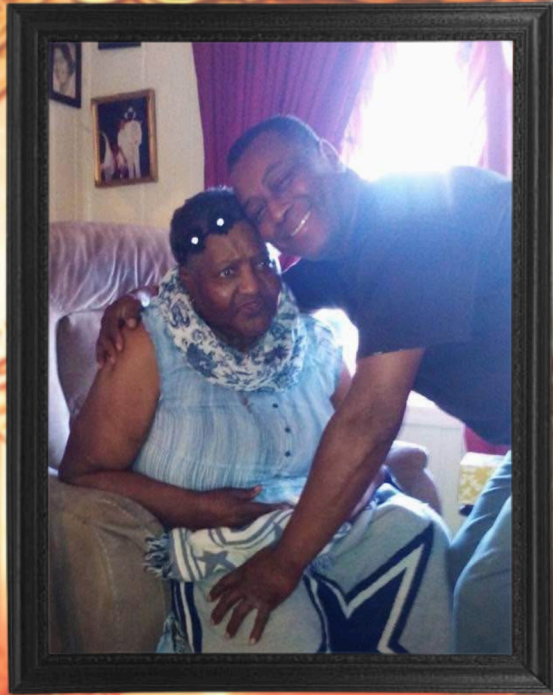

where there are no days and years.

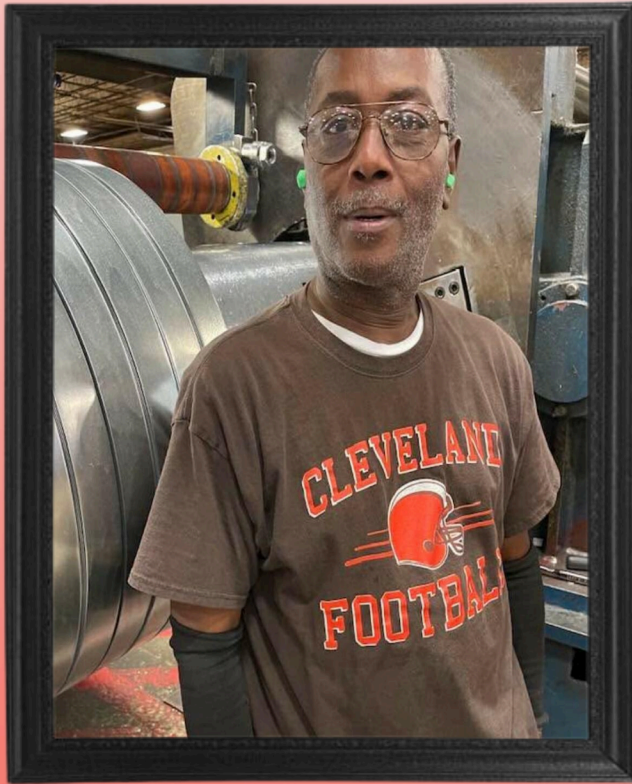
Think how he must be wishing
