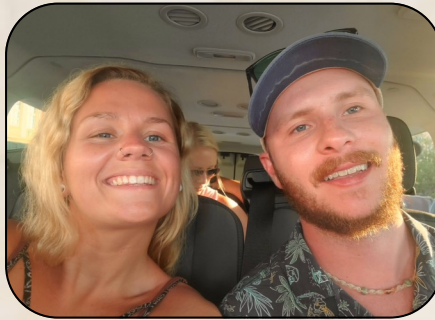
Celebrating the Life of
