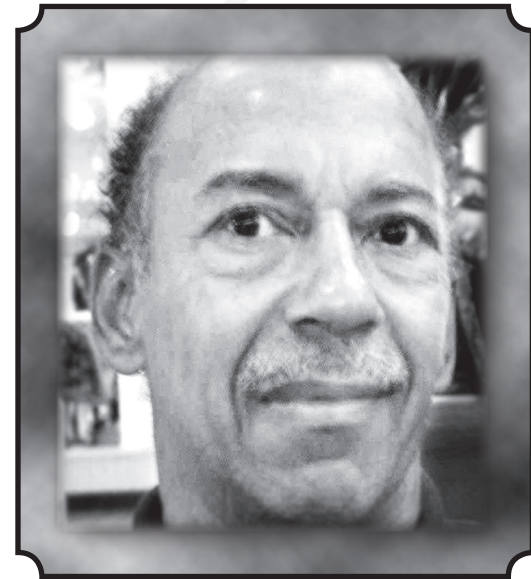

Obituary
