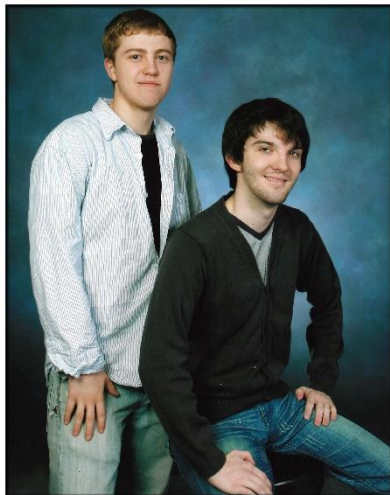
December 7, 1990
