While stationed in Newfoundland, he was engine specialist for the B-29 attached to the Rescue Squadron. He spent

28 days on a Search and Rescue Mission over Greenland searching for a downed airplane and crew which they were unable to find. He also serviced the C-124 cargo planes at the Dover Air Force Base in Delaware. When returning home, he had various truck driving jobs while also helping his father with the farming. His passion for driving lead him to establish his own Trucking business in 1966. He serviced his customers for 50 years. He also helped his father-in-law with farming. LeMoyne was a member of Norway Lutheran Church where you would find him most Sunday mornings.
