# Reflections of Life

Freddie Bell Robinson was born on September 15, 1934 in Keachi, Louisiana to Lillie Mae Fells and Booker T. Robinson. Later moving to Carthage, TX, Freddie Bell was the 2nd oldest of 8 children.

Freddie Bell attended Elementary and Middle School in Carthage, Texas and later attended R.T. Coles School in Kansas City, MO. Before finishing high school, Freddie Bell returned back to Carthage, TX where she found her loved for the Lord and gave her life to Christ at the age of 17. While falling in love with Christ, she also fell in love with Walter Ree Graves and later had two sons together, Walter Graves and Percy Graves.

On September 28, 1963, Birl and Freddie Bell married in Kansas City, MO in Jackson County. The Williams family joined Greater Holy Temple in 1963 and were faithful members before making Trinity Temple Church in God in Christ their church home in 1981.
