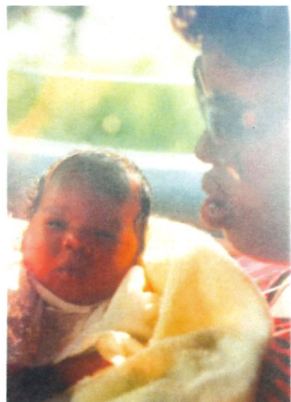


Obituary

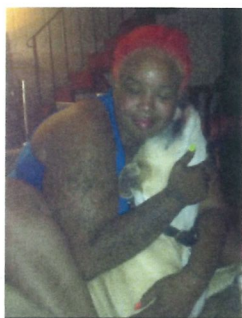
