When the doctor stuck his head out the delivery room door and jokingly asked what they wanted to do with the third one, Cary's response was "put it back!"

The most important thing Carmen did for her life and future was when she accepted Jesus as her Savior in 1984 and was baptized at New Hope Baptist Church in April 1984.

Carmen passed away peacefully in her sleep on March 12, 2026.
