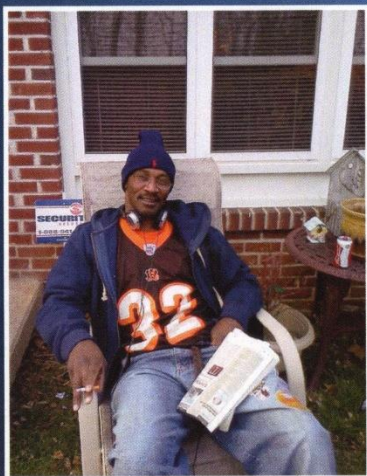
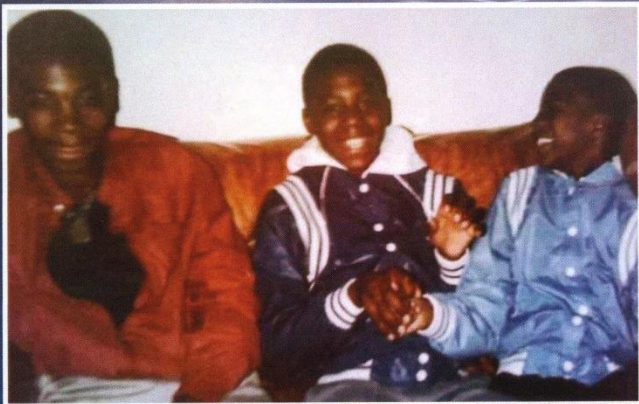
In addition to his father, he was preceded in death by one brother, Charles Scott, III, and a sister, Laynette Scott.
