

GONE FISHIN'



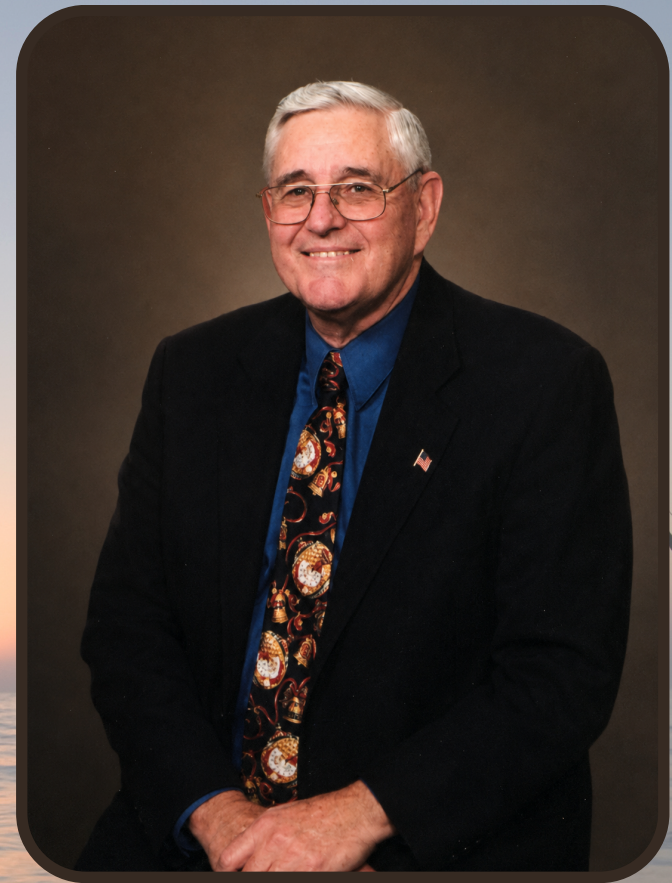
*I've finished life's chores assigned to me,
