
She was preceded in death by her son, Joseph Riveland; father, Dwayne; and maternal and paternal grandparents.



I attended Lien Township p #4 for my first two years of school and then transferred to New Effington. I graduated as salutatorian of my class in 1970. I started Radiology school at St. Francis Hospital in July of that year graduating in July of 1972. I worked at Rolla ND hospital for one year and then returned to St. Francis.

Daryl Edward Riddle was born along with his twin brother to Ruth Ellis and Benjamin P. Riddle at Sioux Valley Hospital in Sioux Falls, SD. He was 3 when his mother died and he was placed in the Children's Home at Sioux Falls.
