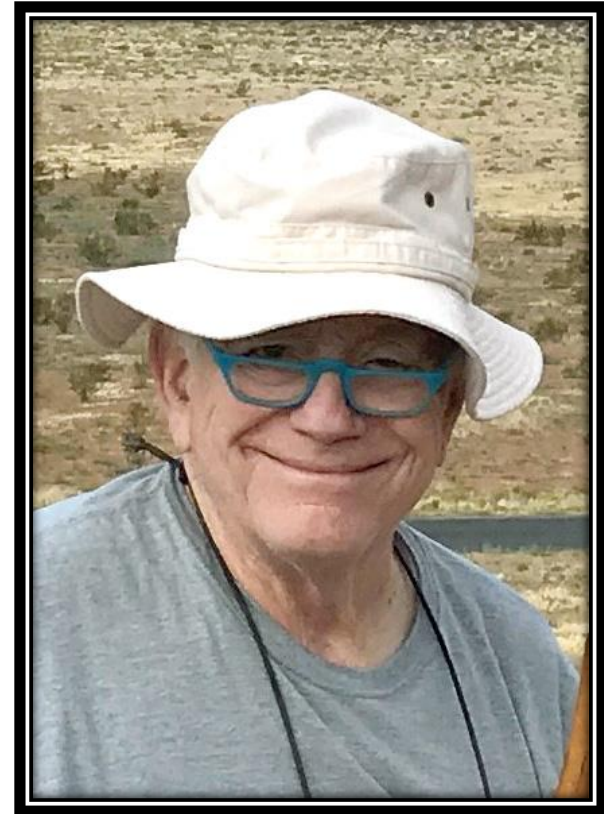
### Abide with me!
