and welcomed you home.

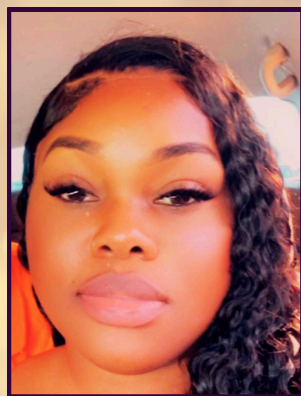
You took a part of your children with you,

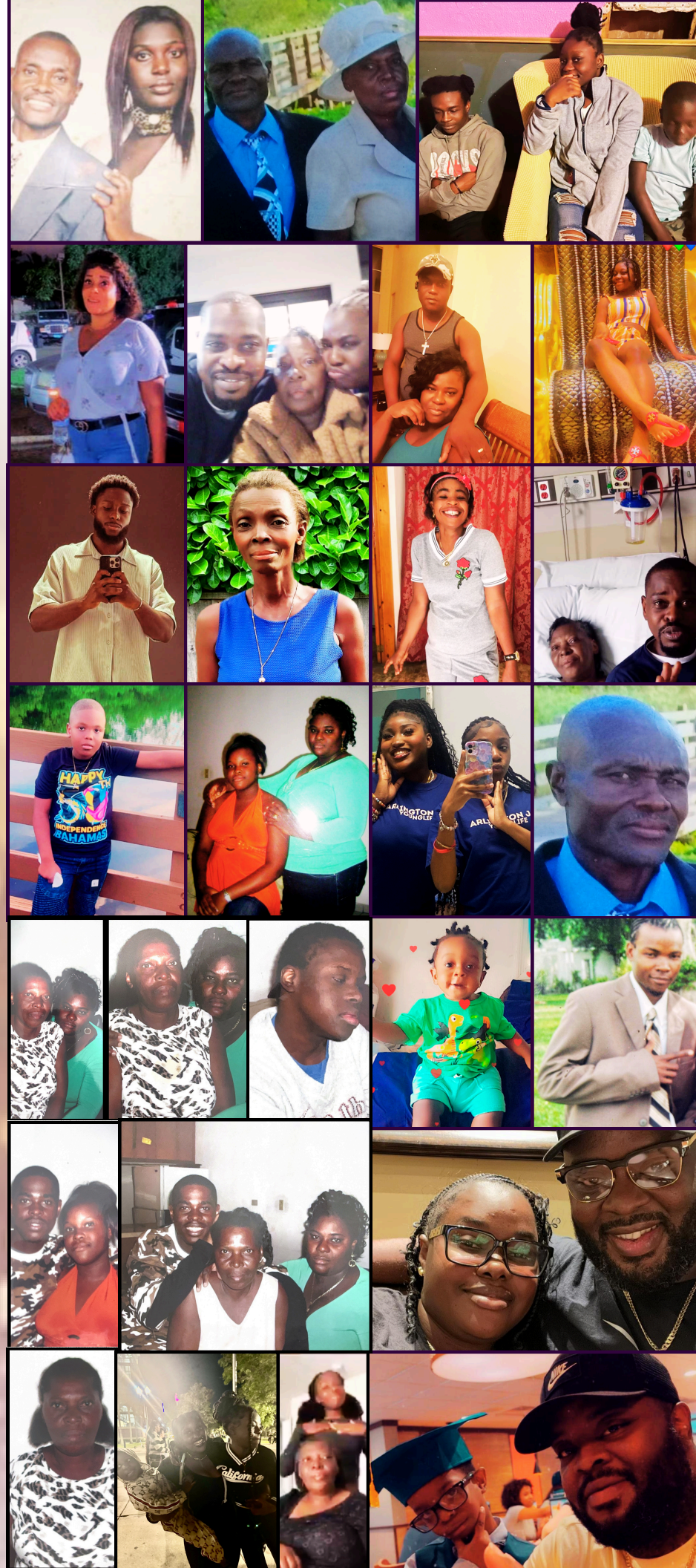

Conserve St Fleur was born on April 22, 1960, in Saint Louis du Nord to Gervil St Fleur and Merina Cadet. At one point in her life, she lived with her father's family, the St Fleur's. Later in life, she had two children before she migrated to the Bahamas, where she had five more children. Conserve St Fleur shared many stories, but the one she spoke of most often was the pain she carried from making the hardest decision of her life-leaving her two children behind. This story stood out because she told it more than many others.

Despite caring for five children, Conserve St Fleur did not work outside of home. She was a stay-at-home mother who raised her children with very little. Through determination and sacrifice, she later brought her second child to join her as her oldest child had already gotten married and had children of her own. Despite her circumstance she sent what little money she could home to support the family.

Conserve St Fleur was a deeply selfless woman who always thought of others before herself. She taught her children to love one another, to love others, and to be kind. Most importantly, she taught those in her care never to forget where we originated from and never to forget the children and family she left behind. Overall, Conserve St Fleur was a loving, kind, and selfless person, and she passed those values on to every child she raised.
