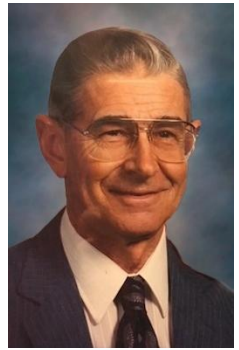


Byron H. Bredael
