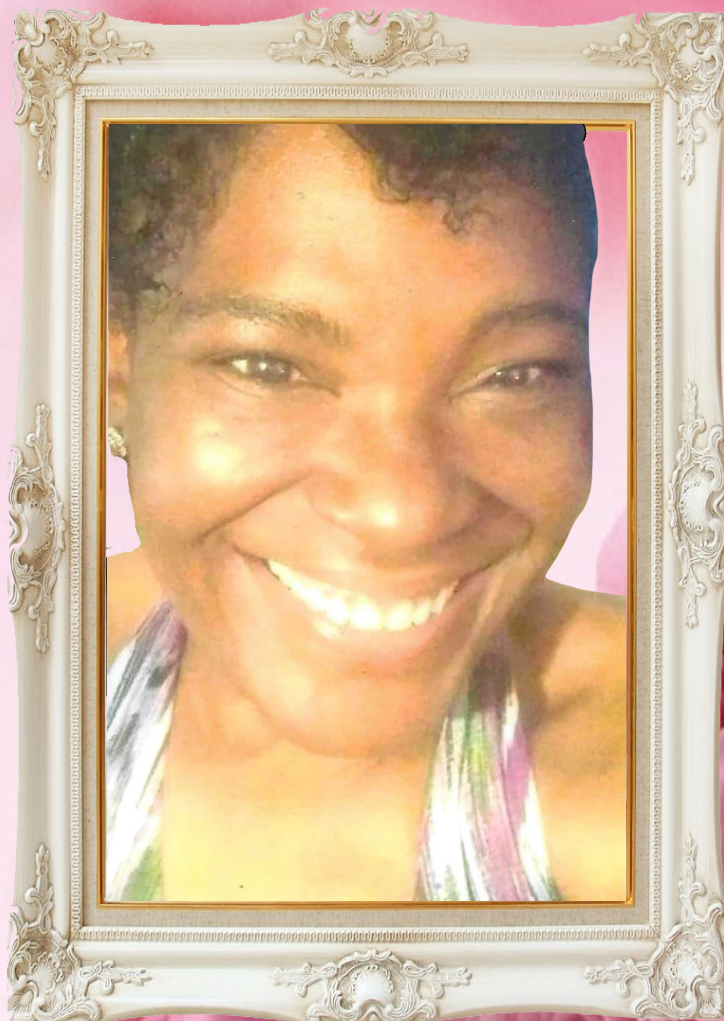

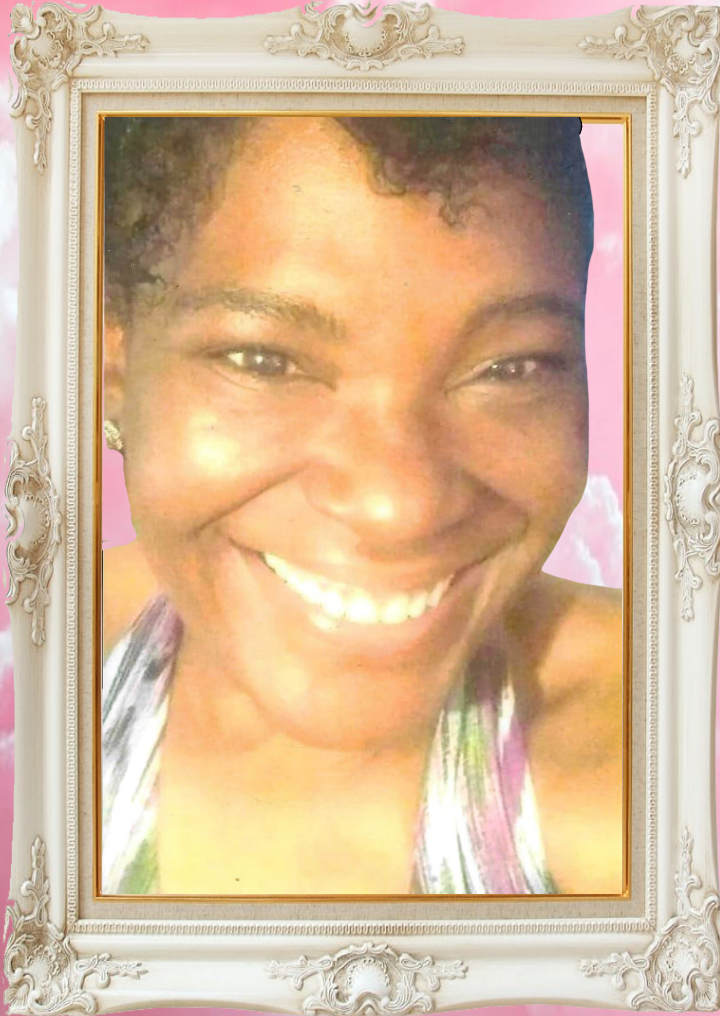

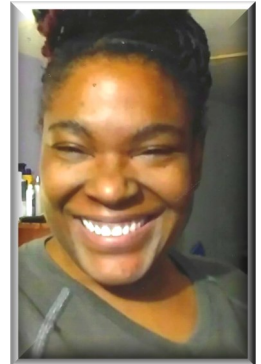
Miss Me, But Let Me Go

soul set free?

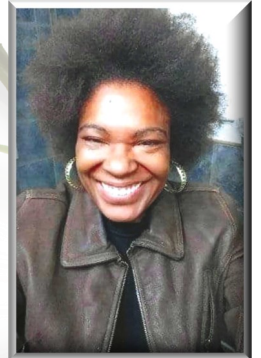


Miss me a little, but not too long
