Richard “Dick” J. Hall, 83, of Moorhead, MN, passed away on Wednesday, March 25, 2026, in Vibra Hospital, Fargo, ND.

Richard “Dick” John Hall was born August 8, 1942, the son of John and Marjorie (Ranger) Hall in Fargo, ND. Raised in Moorhead he graduated from Moorhead State University Campus School and then attended Moorhead State University as a music major. Dick then began his professional career working for Overvold Motors in Fargo.

It was during this time that he met Pat Johnson, and they were united in marriage on August 29, 1964, at St. Joseph’s Catholic Church in Moorhead. The couple first made their home in Moorhead, where they started their family. Dick worked for Dakota Plate and Glass.
