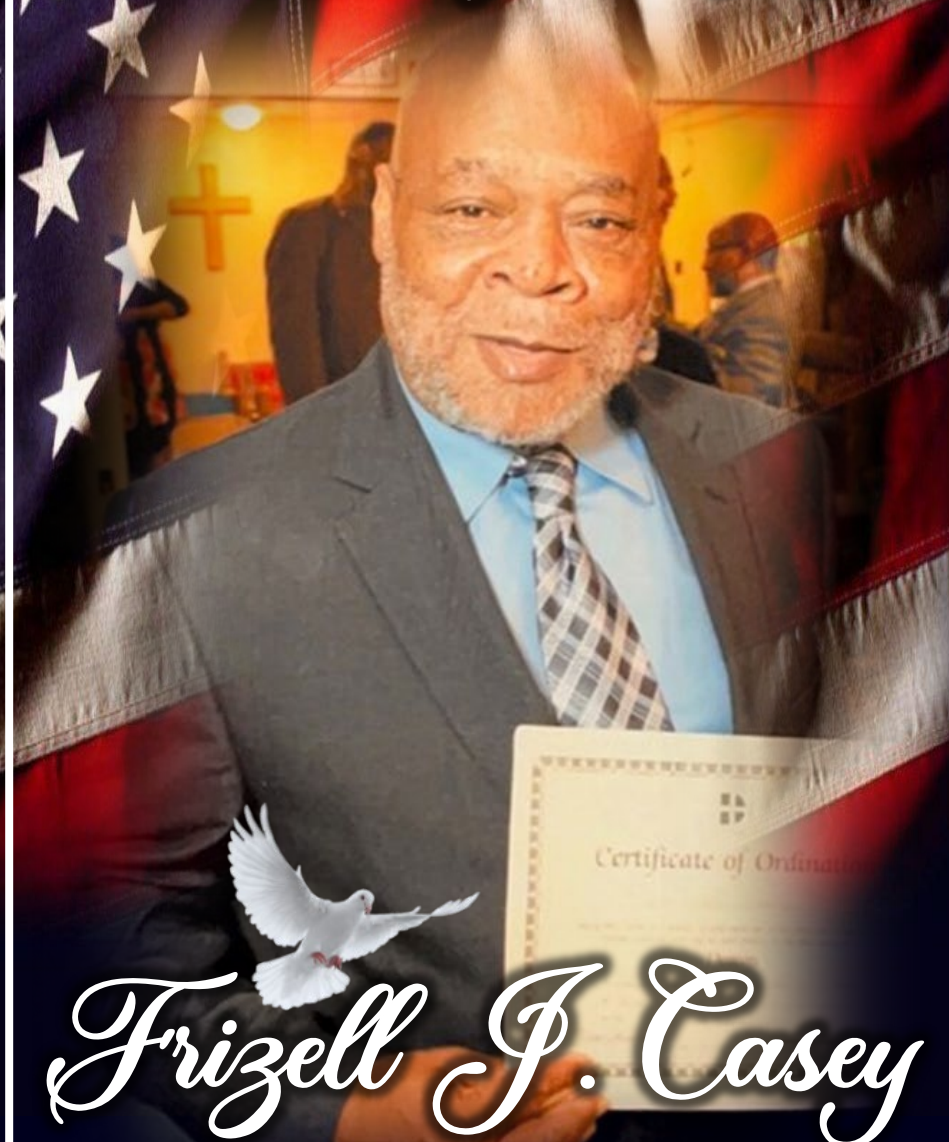

On Sunday, December 11, 1949, Milton Casey and Doretha Houston welcomed their baby boy, Frizell Jobie Casey to the world.

Frizell gave his life to Christ at a very early age and joined New Pilgrim Rest M.B. Church under the guidance of Rev. A. B. Jones. He became a deacon on October 4, 2014, and remained an active member until his health failed. He attended N.D. Taylor High School and graduated with the Class of 1968. He enlisted in the Army December 10, 1970, and served his country for three (3) years and received an Honorable discharge. He was united in Holy Matrimony to Carolyn Casey on June 10, 1974. Through this union two handsome sons were born, Marcus and Marlon Casey.

After working various jobs, Frizell decided to open his own business, The Paint Shop.
