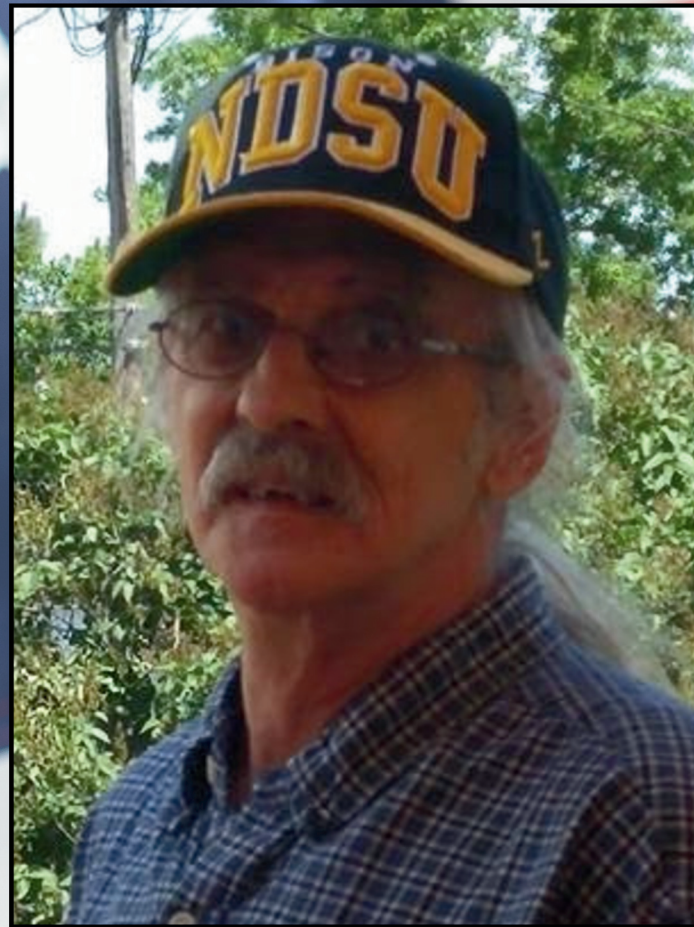

Craig Allen Kjos, 76, Fargo, passed away on June 12, 2026, at the family cabin in Pelican Rapids, MN.
