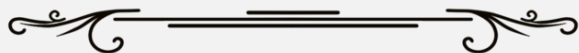

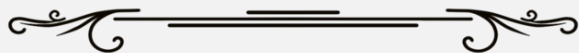
Jerryemiah confessed to Christ at an early age at Issaquena MB Church of Yazoo City, MS under leadership of Pastor Willams.
