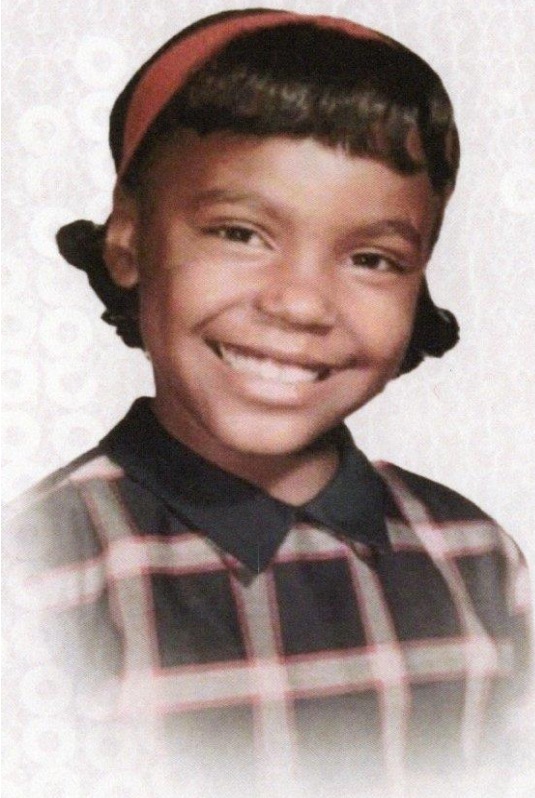

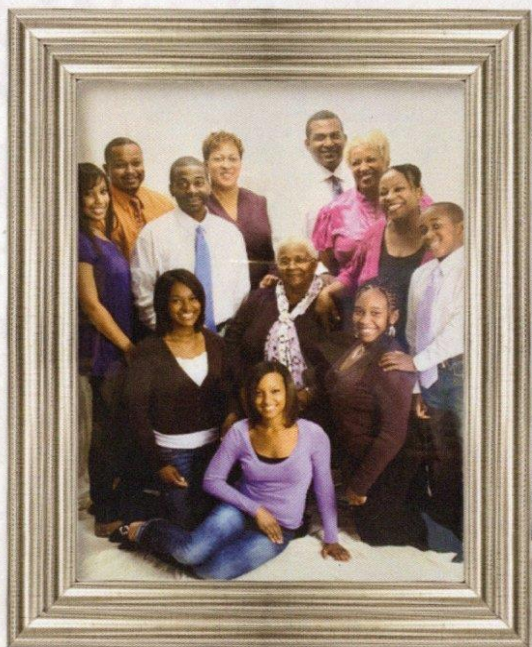




Adrienne Christina King, affectionately known as "Agie," passed into eternal rest, at the age of 66, on Monday afternoon, September 22, 2025, at her residence.

Born in Coatesville, PA, on November 22, 1958, Adrienne graduated from Coatesville Area High School with a focus in cosmetology. She earned her beautician certification from Wilfred Beauty Academy and furthered her education by obtaining her teacher's and instructor's license in 1978.

Adrienne's professional journey was one of passion, dedication, and entrepreneurship. She began as the manager of Soul Scissors Salon in Philadelphia, PA, and later opened a salon in her home. Outside of her career, Adrienne enjoyed uplifting young women, collecting artwork, and watching movies. A true fashionista, she was known for her love of makeup, nail design, sequins, bright colors, and of course, leopard prints and fur coats.



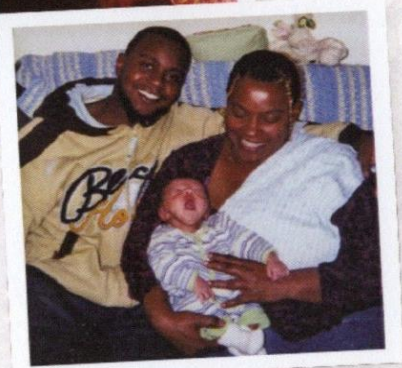
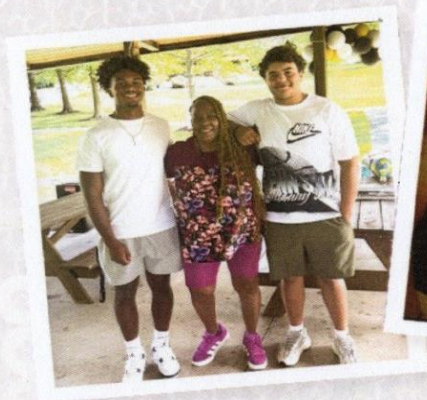
Her bold fashion sense was matched only by her sense of humor, joyful spirit, and her deep, unshakable faith in the Lord.
